CHM-6529	617863	Chamo now supports ten-digit search log identification numbers. Chamo stores a unique search log identification number in the database each time a search is performed. The identification numbers are used to generate report results on searches performed via Chamo. This change increases the total number of search log entries that can be stored in the database.
CHM-6524	617863	Chamo now supports ten-digit circulation transaction ID numbers and transaction reference numbers. This change increases the total number of circulation transactions that the software supports.
CHM-6517	10937	Chamo now runs on Apache Tomcat® version 8.5.34.

CHM-6421		<p>HKPL only: A new <b>Available Item Class/Selected Item Class</b> setting is available on the <b>OPAC Settings</b> administrative screen. This setting determines how Chamo calculates the item availability counts that appear on the <b>Search Results</b> screen in the patron interface.</p> <p>To calculate the item availability counts shown on the <b>Search Results</b> screen, Chamo counts available items that belong to the item classes listed in the <b>Selected Item Class</b> list. You can add an item class to the <b>Selected Item Class</b> list by selecting the item class in the <b>Available Item Class</b> list and clicking <b>Add</b>. To remove an item class from the <b>Selected Item Class</b> list, click the red "X" beside the item class name. Note that if the <b>Selected Item Class</b> list is empty, Chamo counts available items that belong to any item class when calculating item availability counts.</p>
