CHM-6429		When a patron updates the Communication Preference setting via the My Account screen in the Chamo patron interface, any corresponding updates to the notice fields (Next Letter Date, Next Letter Type, Next Letter Count) for the patron's checked out items are now immediately visible on the Patron Activity window in the Virtua client.

Fixed Issues

The following table details the fixed issues for this release.

ID	NetSuite	Fixed Issue Description
CHM-6515	10925	Chamo sometimes displayed an incorrect book cover image on the Search Results screen or the Item Details screen. The problem only occurred when Chamo was configured to display book cover images from Syndetic Solutions. If a bibliographic record contained three or more ISBNs, Chamo displayed the book cover image associated with the first ISBN found in the bibliographic record. This is fixed. Chamo now uses the last ISBN found in the bibliographic record when displaying book cover images.
