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## What's New

The following table details the new features and functionality included in this release.

CHM-6530		<p>HKPL only: Chamo has been upgraded to provide greater flexibility in defining the services used to display the book cover images and additional book information that appears in search results and on the Item Details page.</p> <p>In the Chamo administrative interface, multiple book cover and content services can now be enabled on the External Data Configuration page. In addition to existing services (such as Syndetics and Google Books), the library can now define their own service(s) using a base URL. Staff users can prioritize the list of available services.</p> <p>When multiple services are enabled, Chamo uses enhanced logic to locate content. For each title, Chamo uses the ISBN/ISSN and Bib ID to search service providers in the prioritized order until content is found.</p>
CHM-6763		<p>HKPL only: To maintain the consistency of the user interface, a gray background has been added to the Book Cover and Content Services page in the Chamo administrative interface.</p>
CHM-6735	561153	<p>The guest user feature has been updated in Chamo. Guest users can now perform browse, keyword, heading, and control number searches when logged onto the Virtua Client.</p> <p>This addresses an issue where searches could not be performed due to a problem with REST API authentication.</p>

## Fixed Issues

The following table details the fixed issues for this release.

ID	NetSuite	Fixed Issue Description
CHM-6428	630916	A problem sometimes occurred when placing a Volume Group Request on a bibliographic record with a large number of attached items. Chamo displayed a blank page to the patron after five minutes (indicating the request timed out) even though the request was successfully processed. Additionally, the transaction was not recorded in the circulation transaction log. This problem has been fixed.
CHM-6685	787067	If SSO is enabled in Chamo Admin, the search history was not cleared in Chamo OPAC when a user clicked Clear Session. This is now fixed. The Clear Session link now points to a /clearSession URL to avoid proxy issues that can occur when the user is not logged in.
CHM-6703	789995	A problem occurred when SSO was enabled and patrons attempted to reset their password using the Forgot Password functionality. By default, Chamo displayed the confirmation message verifying that patrons have successfully reset their passwords on the Chamo Login Page. With SSO, patrons were redirected to the SSO Login Portal and therefore could not view this message. This has been fixed. The confirmation message now displays on the Forgot Password page.
