ID	NetSuite	Fixed Issue Description
VIRTUA-24466 808994	Performance was slow when you checked in serial issues on the Bulk Serials Check-in window. This is fixed.	
		As part of this fix, a new No. of Records option is now available on the Received tab of the Bulk Serials Check-in window. To display more serial copies on the Received tab, you can select a value between 20 and 500 from the No. of Records list and then select More. Virtua refreshes the Received tab to display the specified number of additional copies.
VIRTUA-24734	1032986	An error sometimes occurred when you attempted to save a shipping invoice. The problem occurred when a country was selected in the Country field in the shipping account associated with the shipping invoice. This is fixed.
		Virtua now accommodates selecting a country for a shipping account. This change means that a participant can now have multiple shipping accounts associated with different countries. When a shipment invoice is approved, the amount is encumbered to the first available shipping account.

ID	NetSuite	Fixed Issue Description
VIRTUA-24630 970764	970764	In previous versions, it was sometimes not possible to set the Treatment field for an existing multivolume or serial purchase order to "B". (Orders with a Treatment value of "B" are included in the binding list.) The problem occurred when the following conditions were true:
		 The purchase order was created before the LoC binding functionality was added to Virtua. Item records had already been created for the items in the order.
		You can now use the LOCMultiVolumeOrderToSetTreatment.sh script to fix the affected purchase orders.
VIRTUA-24619	967271	LoC only: A problem sometimes occurred when you attempted to correct information entered during the process of receiving a multi-volume purchase order. The problem occurred if you removed one or more volumes from the receipt (for example, because the volume arrived damaged or is now missing) and later created a new purchase order for it. If you then received the volume, Virtua created a second new item record for the volume. The existence of these duplicate item records prevented you from viewing or editing the shipment box for the volume. You can now use the LOCMultiVolumeWithBoxes.sql
		script to remove all such items from shipment boxes.
VIRTUA-24610	1027982, 954622	Problems sometimes occurred when you used the Uncheck-In button to undo a bulk serials check-in and later checked the affected issues in again. If one or more of the items was already assigned to a shipment box, checking the issue in again removed the link between the item record and the purchase order. This prevented you from updating the Box ID or Shipment ID.
		You can now use the LOCBulkSerialIssueWithBoxes.sh script to remove all such items from shipment boxes.
